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### Prospectus

An updated prospectus has been sent home to each family today. I appreciate it is a lengthy document but please make time to read it as it contains all the most up to date information regarding routines etc in school. Can I remind parents that if you have any questions regarding school please see your child's class teacher who will happily help. There are always a few teething problems at the beginning of a school year as we all settle back into a routine but these can quickly and easily be sorted through joint communication.

### PE each Tuesday

We had decided that the children would change in school each Tuesday for PE however with an increase in numbers and a lack of space this has proved to be difficult and time consuming so we will revert back to the arrangement we had last year. **ALL children to come to school each Tuesday in t-shirt, jogging bottoms with a jumper and trainers. They can stay in this all day and do not need their uniform with them. Please remember if children wear ear rings these should be flat sleepers only for school and should be removed for PE and swimming.**

### Morning routine

Each morning all classes will line up on the yard at 8:45am where they will be met by their class teacher. As part of their growing independence all children (including those in Reception) will be expected to come in to school independently where they will be helped by members of staff to organise their things for the day. The infant peg area can get particularly congested so from a health and safety perspective we ask that parents let the children come in on their own. Please say goodbye to your child on the yard before they line up.

### Dinner Money & Milk

Unfortunately there was a mistake on the dinner money calculation on last weeks letter. The cost per child (in KS2) is £2.30 per child per day not £2.40 as was previously stated therefore the cost of this half terms lunches will be **£78.20** for those having a lunch every day. If you have already paid the previous amount stated the difference this will be deducted from next half terms bill. Class 1 only - If you would like your child to have Milk during morning break please contact Mrs Lewis. The charge per half term for milk for Reception and Year 1 is £7.50. Please make cheques Payable to LCC ( Lancs County Council) In line with Council policy all lunches must be paid for **in advance** not arrears. Payments can be made daily/ weekly or termly.
