

<p><u>English</u></p> <p>The main focus in English lessons will be Aladdin and will cover narrative, non-fiction and poetry. The work on Aladdin will also include reading skills. We will also use key reading skills and create some cross-curricular writing during Enterprise week and as part of our 'Celebrations' topic.</p>	 <p style="text-align: center;">Class 2 Topic Web Summer Term 2022 <u>Celebrations</u></p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Mrs Norton will be focusing on multiplication and division. The children will learn methods and facts to answer a range of multiplication and division questions. Money, addition and subtraction, time and reasoning skills will also be revisited.</p> <p>Mrs Hargreaves will be looking at fractions; and using fractions in connection with money, measures, data-handling, shapes and telling the time.</p>
<p>Like last term, Big Writes will continue weekly, giving the children opportunities to write different text types focusing on a variety of styles of writing, adapting for different audiences and developing vocabulary, grammar and spelling.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>The science topics for this term will be plants and living things including animals – skeletons and movement. We will take opportunities to grow plants and get outside to make observations. We will compare skeletons and learn about the functions of our bones.</p>	<p><u>History and Geography</u></p> <p>Our history work will be about British Kings and Queens. We will focus on King Henry VIII and Queen Elizabeth I and learn about the Tudor period.</p> <p>In geography, we will find out about Commonwealth countries and locate them on the map, with a special focus on Canada. We will also find out about the countries that make up Europe and further develop our map skills. We will learn about key physical and human features of the places we focus on.</p>
<p>Spelling lessons will continue to take place daily and grammar will be taught throughout daily English lessons.</p> <p>Regular Guided Reading sessions will also continue throughout this term.</p> <p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>In our computing sessions, the children will use technology to create pictures and documents. They will also learn about simulations. Further work and discussions</p>	<p><u>R.E. and P.S.H.E</u></p> <p>Throughout this term we will be thinking about celebrations in different religions as well as personal celebrations – thinking about how special we each are and how we can celebrate this.</p> <p>We will be thinking about rights and responsibilities; and learning that the two go hand in hand.</p> <p><u>Music and Spanish</u></p> <p>Ms Perez will continue to teach Music and Spanish to Class 2. Much of the singing work will be in preparation for our end of term show.</p>
