

English

This term we will be basing some of our English learning around our class novel *Journey to the River Sea* by Eva Ibbotson. The children will write their own narrative based on the story and make links with our geography learning about Brazil.

We will also be exploring and writing our own poetry based on Celebration poems from different cultures.

Reading and writing different text types will also be a large part of our work in History and Geography as the children apply their English skills across the curriculum.

Big Writes will continue weekly, giving the children opportunities to write different text types focusing on a variety of styles of writing, adapting for different audiences and developing vocabulary, grammar and spelling.

Spelling lessons take place daily and grammar will be taught throughout the English units and during specific grammar lessons, giving the children opportunities to use and apply their new learning in their independent reading and writing.

Science



Our Science topics for this term will be Evolution & Inheritance and Electricity.

Class 3 Topic Web Summer Term 2022



R.E.



Throughout the year we will be continuing to explore the key question *Is life like a journey?*

We will learn about the Buddhist faith and focus on the question *What do we mean by a good life?*

We will then sun up the focus of the year with a return to Christian beliefs and think about how the Christian faith would approach the question *If life is like a journey, what's the destination?*

History



In history we will be learning about Royalty to link with The Queen's Jubilee. We will look at William the Conqueror's reign from 1066 onwards, how King John made himself very unpopular as monarch and why King Henry VIII married so many times. We also learn about who Queen Anne was, what Queen Victoria achieved during her reign and look at the role of the British monarchy today.

Maths

This term, we will be revisiting our learning from the year so far, with a particular focus on place value, number and the four operations. The children will learn to apply these skills through units on time, money, position and direction, algebra and ratio. (UKS2).

Our daily 'Flashback 4' questions help the children revisit learning from last term so that they maintain familiarity with new concepts learned and are given opportunities to practise the formal written methods for calculation.

Alongside this, we will continue to learn times tables, practise mental maths skills and develop perseverance and resilience in problem solving activities.

Geography



We will be learning about Brazil as our study of a region in South America. We will discover the human and physical geography including settlement and land use, climate, biomes and rivers. We will also learn about the *Carnival* festival celebrated in Brazil.
