## <u>English</u>

Our main learning in English for the first halfterm will be based on our class novel *The Nowhere Emporium,* by Ross Mackenzie. The children will produce short and longer pieces of writing based on our learning including a narrative and an information text.

In the second half-term we will be learning about older classic fiction and poetry based around our Geography topic about Mexico.

Big Writes will continue on a regular basis, giving the children opportunities to write different text types focusing on a variety of styles of writing, adapting for different audiences and developing vocabulary, grammar and spelling.

Spelling and grammar lessons take place weekly, along with guided reading sessions, giving the children opportunities to use and apply their new learning in their independent reading and writing.



#### Music

Mrs King will continue to teach music. This term the focus will be on singing,

playing instruments, improvising, composing and performing (singing focus).

# Computing

In computing, the children will be studying coding, internet safety, and how to use and create spreadsheets.

### <u>Art/D.T</u>

In Art and DT, the children will be exploring and developing ideas linked to drawing and sculpture.
