### <u>English</u>


We will be enjoying lots of books this term following our 'Anyone for Tea?' theme. Our main class reader will be Alice in Wonderland.

# R.E. and P.S.H.E




In RE, we will be looking at food in religious traditions. Our focus religions will be Islam and Christianity.
