



Key Stage 2 Results – 2023-24

There were 9 children in Year 6 in 2024. Reading, Maths, Grammar Spelling and Punctuation results were generated from test papers, the writing was teacher assessed.

The range of scaled scores available for each KS2 test are:

- 80 is the lowest possible scaled score
- 120 is the highest possible scaled score

A scaled score of 100 or more means that the child has met the expected standard in each test; a scaled score of 99 or less means they haven't reached the government-expected standard.
