Pupil Premium Strategy

2024-25

Purpose

The Pupil Premium grant is additional funding to improve educational outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in state-funded schools in England.

Funding Criteria

Pupil Premium funding is allocated to eligible schools based on the number of pupils who are recorded as eligible for free school meals, or have been recorded as eligible in the past 6 years (referred to as Ever 6 FSM)

Pupil premium is not a personal budget for individual pupils, and schools do not have to spend pupil premium so that it solely benefits pupils who meet the funding criteria. It can be used:

- to support other pupils with identified needs, such as those who have or have had a social worker, or who act as a carer
- for whole class interventions which will also benefit non-disadvantaged pupils

Whilst the staff, Governors and Trustees review our provision and strategies annually, due to the low number of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium, we are not required to publish an updated 'Strategy Statement' as part of our grant conditions, however further information can be made available on request.
